SESOBEL is a day program. The children live at home to be part of their family's life. SESOBEL uses a holistic, family-focused approach to assess and customize each child's needs and care, regardless of their economic situation or sectarian affiliation.

Physical Disabilities

SESOBEL provides

- physical therapy
- psychomotor therapy
- adaptive devices to promote mobility
- health checks through a network of volunteer doctors.

SESOBEL is known for our care of degenerative diseases. Without therapy the child's conditions will deteriorate.

Severe Autism—SESOBEL provides education plus therapies to promote self-calming such as music, art, and visual and light therapy.

Training and Research—SESOBEL has joint research projects with Lebanese universities and international organizations. The results are academically published. In addition, SESOBEL offers training sessions for medical and social professionals.

Intellectual Disabilities

SESOBEL provides

- adapted education
- vocational education
- promoting self-reliance and self-advocacy
- training for everyday living.

Social— SESOBEL partners with the family to understand and accept the child's special needs. Parents and siblings coordinate with staff to prepare a plan for the child's future. Adapting to Lebanon's situation, SESOBEL often provides medications and food to poor families.
